Important data

1830 Thomas Rudder Davis is born on 8th December.

1868 On Whit Monday Thomas R. Davis rode from Gloucester to Cheltenham on a velocipede he had built.

1875 Foundation of Victoria Bicycle Works in Cheltenham.

1875 A. Chatwin wrote in 1971 that Thomas R. Davis was the only manufacturer of velocipedes in Cheltenham in 1875.

1879 On 08th November an advertisement by Thomas Davis Junior is published in the Cheltenham Mercury.

1881 Thomas Davis Junior founds his own bicycle manufactory. Central Bicycle Works, in Cheltenham.

1884 On 15th January Thomas R. Davis dies in his workshop.

1885 From July Charlotte and her son Nathaniel continue to run Victoria Works.

1885 The last advertisement of Central Bicycle Works, Cheltenham is published.

1888 A Bicycle Road Book with cycle routes starting from Cheltenham is published.

1891 On 2nd September 1891 the last known advertisement of T. Davis Co. was published.

Wichtige Daten

1830 Am 08. Dezember kommt Thomas Rudder Davis zur Welt.

1868 Am Pfingstmontag fuhr Thomas R. Davis mit einem von ihm gebauten Velocipede von Gloucester nach Cheltenham.

1875 Gründung der Victoria Bicycle Works in Cheltenham.

1875 A. Chatwin schrieb 1971, dass Thomas R. Davis im Jahr 1875 der einzige Hersteller von Velocipedes in Cheltenham war.

1879 Am 08. November erscheint im Cheltenhamer Mercury eine Annonce von Thomas Davis Junior.

1881 Thomas Davis Junior gründet seine eigene Fahrradmanufaktur. Die Central Bicycle Works, in Cheltenham.

1884 Am 15. Januar stirbt Thomas R. Davis in seiner Werkstätte.

1885 Ab dem Juli führen Charlotte und ihr Sohn Nathaniel die Victoria Works weiter.

1885 Erscheint die letzte Annonce der Central Bicycle Works, Cheltenham.

1888 Erscheint ein Bicycle Road Book mit Fahrradrouen von Cheltenham ausgehend.

1891 Am 02. September 1891 erschien die letzte bekannte Annonce der T. Davis Co.
